Class 1	Open ODE	BE100 Test 104 (2023)	90cm
Class 2	Novice ODE	BE 90 Test 94 (2023)	80cm
Class 3	Starters ODE	BE 90 Test 91 (2009)	70cm
Class 4	Pairs XC	Run over Novice Course	80cm

**Class 2** - Combination not to have won any horse trials/ODE over a course of 75cms or above and must not have completed a Riding Club ODE, Pony Club Horse Trials or BE Event at 90cms or above.

**Class 3** - Combination not to have won any ODE at any height and not to have completed any area BE Horse Trials/One Day Event (excludes PC camp events)

**Class 4** - Open to any combination - May be junior/senior. **Horses CANNOT have competed in ODE.** HC Entries will be accepted but remain HC in all classes entered.

PLEASE NOTE when entering that we run the OPEN CLASS first in the morning (higher fences) with the STARTERS CLASS (lower fences) taking place in the afternoon

Where possible Classes will be split Junior/Senior (Juniors 18 years and under as of 1/1/25).

Best Dressage Score in each section will receive a special rosette.

**FOR EVENT ENTRIES** For your entry to be processed it is necessary to disclose some of the information you have provided to relevant MDRC Committee members. Your results will be displayed on the MDRC website. "If you receive an injury as the direct result of an accident occurring whilst you are participating at this event, any medical reports relating to your condition will be passed to British Riding Clubs". By submitting your entry you are agreeing to the above.

**XC and SJ Course available for walking from 2.00pm Saturday 24 May.**  
Course may also be walked on day taking care as horses will be on course.

**THIS COMPETITION IS RUN UNDER BRITISH RIDING CLUB RULES** (Horses must be 5YO or over)

**FOR THE CROSS COUNTRY PHASE** riders must wear Long sleeves/Body protector to Beta-Level 3/Skull cap (no fixed peak), please see BRC website for hat standards, and are advised to wear a Medical armband. It is the responsibility of the rider to have acceptable standards.

**PLEASE NOTE** if you are **eliminated** in the show jumping or **score and/or exceed 24 jumping faults** you **WILL NOT** be allowed to compete cross country.

**PLEASE ENSURE YOU READ OUR XC RULES & GUIDELINES FOR RIDERS & FAQ** available on our website, especially regarding dress/tack and WHIP RULES. It is further advised that an up-to-date standard body protector is worn.

**TOWING OFF** – Should your vehicle require towing, fees will apply £30/per hour +VAT (paid directly at the time on the day to the driver)

**PLEASE NOTE:-**

Macclesfield & District Riding Club rules and Health & Safety Policy apply, available from our website – [www.maccridingclub.com](http://www.maccridingclub.com). Competitors enter at their own risk.

Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied at the event by an adult at all times. Any unaccompanied children will NOT be allowed to compete.

**In the event of inclement weather, we reserve the right to cancel this event.**

Please be respectful to the facilities. No galloping allowed in lorry park, only use warm-up area provided. All dogs to be kept on leads at all times. Please take your litter home and leave lorry park tidy.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **When do I get my times?**

*Times are published on the website on the Thursday night preceding the competition. Alternatively you can **call Barbara on 01477 544593** between 7-9pm on the Thursday night.*

### **Do I need a number bib?**

*Yes you need to use a number bib. You may use your own or you can use one of ours for a £10 refundable deposit (it helps us if you can bring the correct amount). Please collect your number when you declare.*

### **Can my dressage test be called?**

*Tests may be read for the Starters class ONLY, all other classes must be ridden from memory.*

### **Can I use any bit for my dressage test?**

*No, for dressage it must be a snaffle bit only. PLEASE NOTE Wilkie snaffle **NOT** acceptable*

### **Can I use a whip for my dressage test?**

*Yes a schooling whip is allowed in the class, both warm up and test*

### **When can I have my dressage sheet?**

*Dressage sheets can be collected from the secretary's office once the results are announced OR hand in a stamped self-addressed envelope at the office and your test to be posted.*

### **Can I still go cross country if I am eliminated in the show jumping?**

*No, if you are eliminated or get a score of 24 or more show jumping faults you will NOT be allowed to go cross country.*

### **What will happen if I am not wearing the correct riding wear for the cross country**

*You will not be allowed to compete XC if you do not have a body protector, skull cap and long sleeved top.*

### **What happens if I fall off?**

*Fall of a rider at any stage of the competition whether in dressage/show jumping arena or on cross country will result in elimination. If you fall in the warm up, the rider must be checked over by first aid and declared fit to ride prior to remounting and continuing.*

### **How are the scores calculated?**

*You attain a percentage score in your dressage test, which is deducted from 100 to determine your penalty score. Any penalties (faults) incurred during SJ and XC phases are added to your dressage score to determine your total penalties. Lowest score wins. In the event of a tie in scores, the collective marks from the dressage score and time in XC phase determine places.*

### **How soon will the scores come out?**

*The scores are posted periodically during the course of the class. The final scores are posted as soon as possible after the last rider has completed their cross country round. The presentation will follow shortly after, subject to any queries/objections being resolved.*
